Trustee Schock inquired about the upcoming ADA compliance. Manager Cardenas stated we are working on it. We are currently working with our website provider Streamline. Trustee Osum asked about the service request numbers from January to February why there is an increase. Manager Cardenas stated that we are inspecting the previous year's swimming pools and ponds that required treatment.

Trustee Stanish asked if we could make comparisons on pesticide use from the previous year, like the lab report. Manager Cardenas stated that yes, we can add that to the Manager's Report.

Trustee Smith inquired about the abandoned pool. He asked if we could ask them to be drained. Manager Cardenas stated that the pools could pop out of the ground in some cases. He also stated that we treat the pools with pesticide and mosquito fish depending on circumstance.

Trustee Osum inquired about how we get bids for the pesticides. Manager Cardenas stated that they sell by availability. Trustee Smith asked how many vendors we have. Manager Cardenas stated that we rotate between three vendors and the availability of each. Trustee Johnsen asked if we use all the pesticides to which Manager Cardenas stated that yes, we do. Trustee Smith asked if we stored the pesticide on site. Manager Cardenas stated yes, we store it on site here and at the airport. We use the pesticide first-in first-out.
