- b. District Manager timekeeping & accountability policy – Vice-President M. White. (Informational)

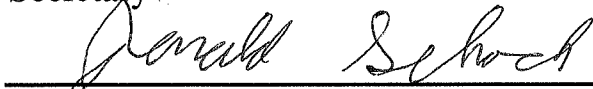
Trustee White went over the document regarding District Manager Timekeeping. After discussion, it was decided to send the document to the Boucher Law, PC firm, for further review.
